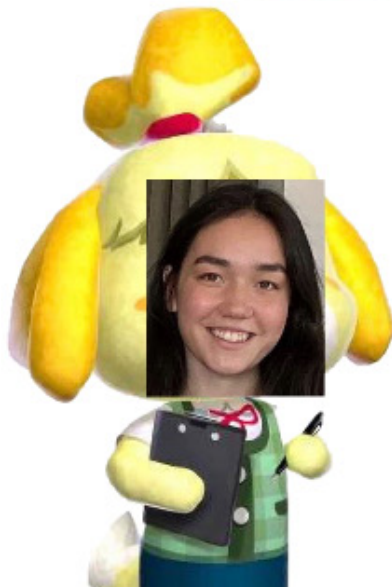

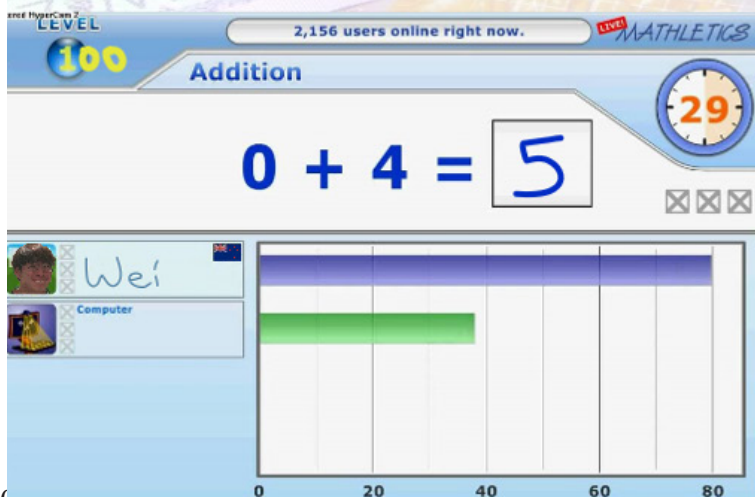

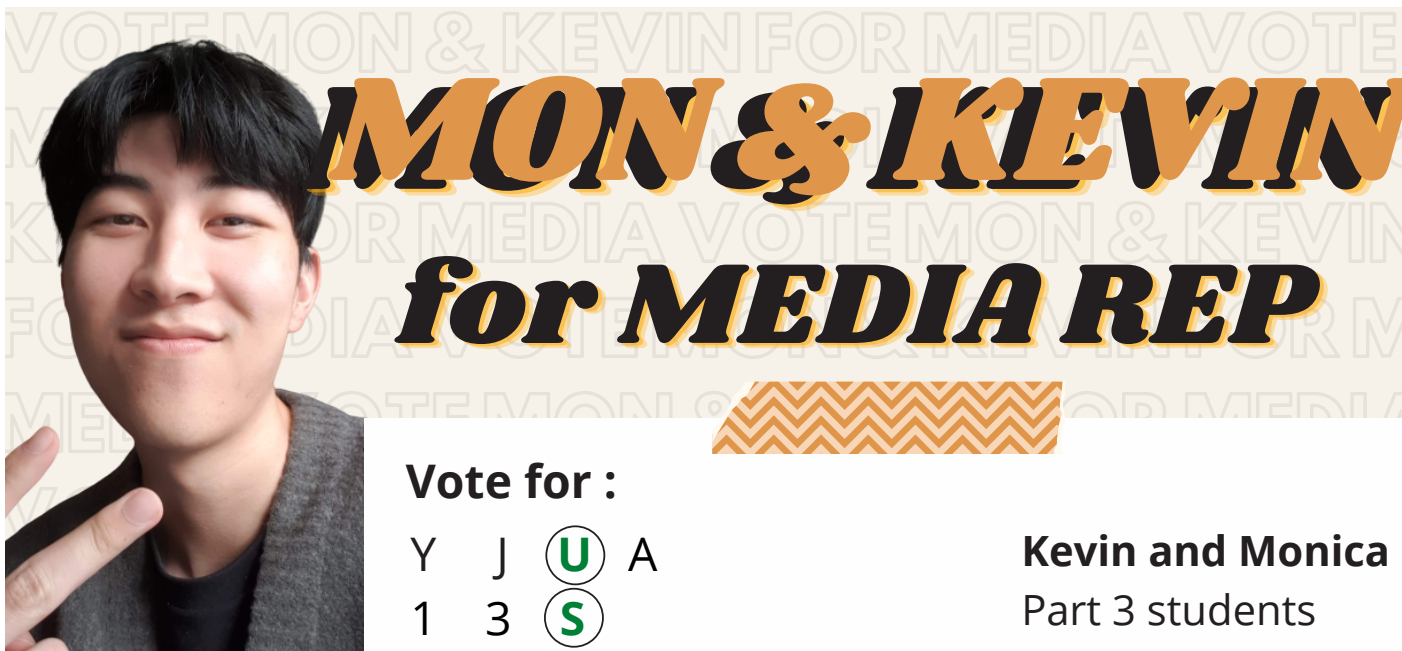
Hellooo fellow pharm students!! For those who don't know me I'm Vida, I'm in third year & I'm running to be YOUR 2021 treasurer.

I have lived in the beautiful rural town of Whanganui (NOT to be confused with Whangarei) ever since I was four years old.



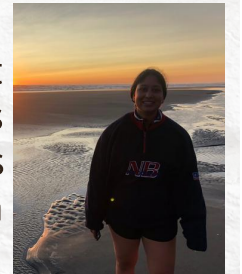

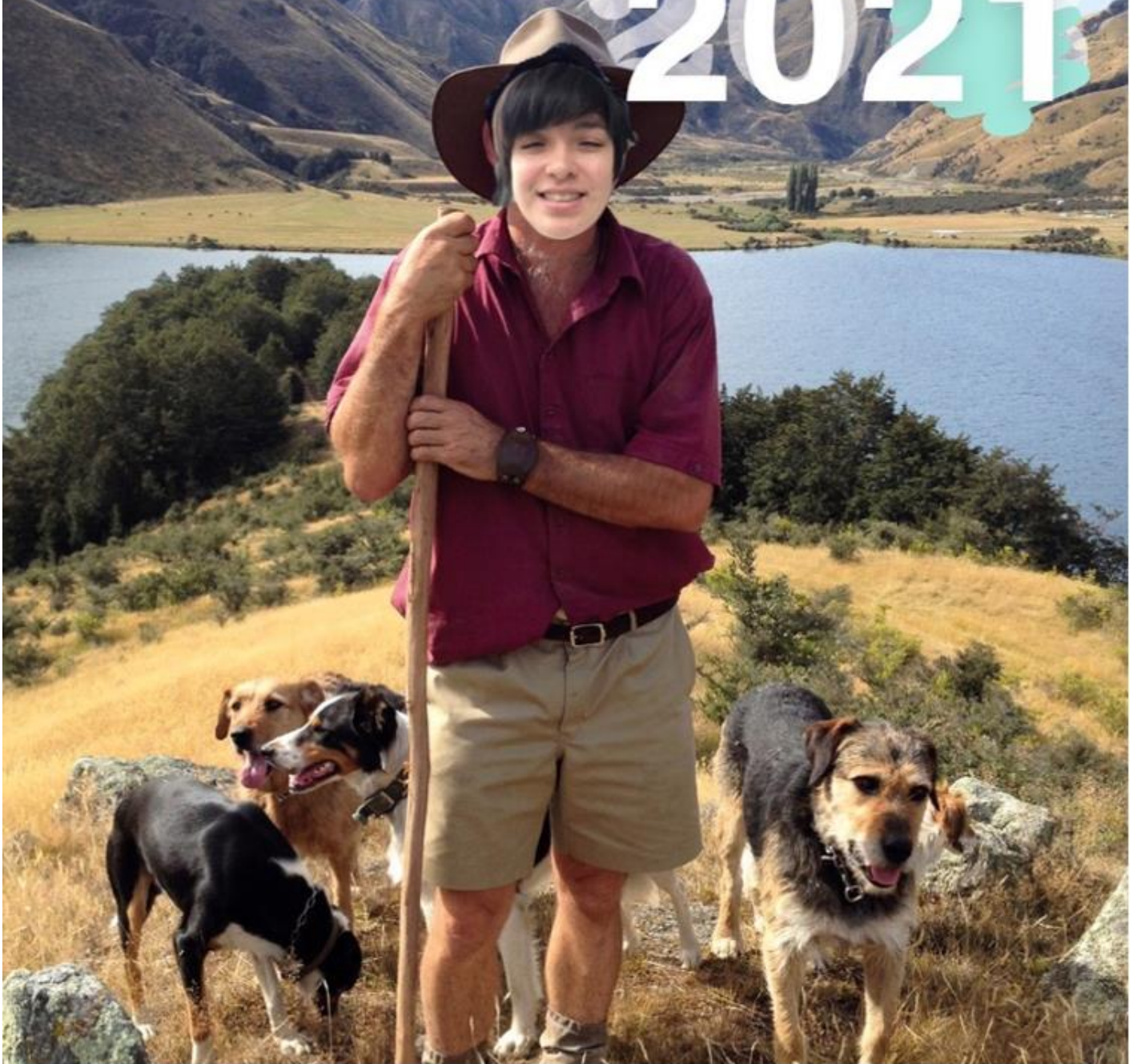
If elected, I'm hoping to build on rural events that unfortunately weren't able to be carried out this year due to COVID and raise further awareness about the disparities between rural and urban health.

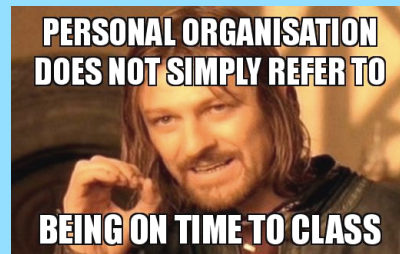

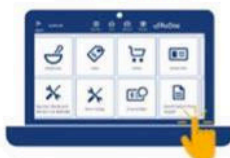
